In the past, supervisors contacted a sampling of businesses to ask for feedback on health inspections. This was time consuming and only reached a small number of businesses.

After your next inspection, your inspector will give you a card with the survey link on it. The survey link will also be in the email from your inspector when you receive your health inspection report.
