Homework Helper Neighborhood Priority Plan

The Bottineau Neighborhood Association (BNA) proposes to use up to \$4,000 of Neighborhood Priority Program funds to expand the Homework Helper program at Bottineau Park.

The current Homework Helper program focuses on students in grades 5-12 and is held just once a week at the Park. There is a demand for the program to run more often to provide a higher level of service to students who access this service – many of whom are immigrants.

Twin Cities Tutoring currently provides trained volunteers to staff the Homework Helper program, and is committed to continuing its efforts. Program space and additional support is provided by Bottineau Park staff.

The additional funds would be used to coordinate the expanded efforts and to provide needed supplies, such as pencils, graph paper, spiral tablets and erasers.

This Priority was first developed in conjunction with Bottineau's 2017-19 Community Participation Program (CPP) submission. The BNA board reaffirmed its commitment on the Priority at its meeting on January 10.
