Utility Box Wraps
Neighborhood Priority Plan

The Kenny Neighborhood Association (KNA) proposes a new Neighborhood Priority to wrap utility boxes in order to enhance the public spaces of the neighborhood and deter graffiti.

Starting at the Kenny Neighborhood Annual Meeting in 2015, we have been holding Town Hall type meetings and small group discussions focused on identifying new and updated priorities for Kenny Neighborhood. Wrapping utility boxes is a project that was frequently mentioned and rose to the top of a list of suggested projects. Neighbors embrace this project as a way to keep the neighborhood looking clean and vibrant by installing public art and deterring graffiti at the same time.

KNA would like to honor the desire of its residents and proceed with wrapping up to four utility boxes in the neighborhood. We plan to engage the local middle school art teacher and students to explore and create unique designs reflective of Kenny neighborhood.

To accomplish this Priority Plan, we will roll forward \$3,500 of unused NRP Phase II Action Plan funds to this newly identified priority within our Community Participation Plan. A public vote approving both the funding mechanism and Priority Plan was taken during the Kenny Annual Meeting on April 18, 2017.
