Grants, Events and Senior Education
Neighborhood Priority Plan
Adopted 3/8/2017

The Fulton Neighborhood Association (FNA) proposes a continuation of our Small Grants Program Priority and the establishment of two new priorities.

The Fulton Small Grants Program was first approved on 5/14/14 as a Neighborhood Priority Plan and launched in 2015. We have funded several organizations providing services focused on youth, senior and community engagement efforts as outlined in our Phase II Plan. We would like to continue that priority into the 2017-2019 Community Participation Program.

In addition, we would like to establish a priority **for biking and pedestrian friendly events**. Through previous casual surveying and documented participation, the neighborhood has strongly supported events focused on alternative transportation methods and pedestrian safety. Given our proximity to W. 50th St and ongoing traffic concerns, there is strong interest by neighborhood residents for events, education and activities which will promote better and safer use of our established infrastructure.

Lastly, we would like to establish a priority supporting **senior education**. One of our most popular Fulton Small Grants supported a senior balance management class. Feedback revealed interest in an additional series of classes addressing a wide variety of senior topics. We struggle to find real and purposeful ways to engage our senior population and want to respond to their interest.

FNA will work with a variety of local community groups, Open Streets and senior programs to carry out these priorities.

In order to fund these three priorities, FNA requests to roll forward its unused CPP reserve funds from the 2014-2016 funding cycle. Additionally, FNA would like to contract their 2017 reserve priority funds with the intention to contract 2018 and 2019 when funding becomes available.
