

# Sheridan Neighborhood Organization Neighborhood Priority Plan Raingardens

Sheridan Neighborhood Organization (SNO) proposes working with Metro Blooms to support the installation of up to 10 raingardens annually.

Metro Blooms has been working on neighborhood raingardens for several years, and focuses on large-scale community participation in the installation of raingardens to create awareness of raingardens and the landscape choices every property owner can make in their yard to protect our clean water.

SNO will recruit residents interested in hosting a raingarden. Residents will attend a Raingarden Workshop and pay for necessary plants. Metro Blooms will complete site consultation and raingarden design, and then work with the Conservation Corps to excavate, haul away soil, and mulch the gardens. It is estimated that each raingarden will cost the neighborhood organization \$590.
