Housing & Transportation Planning: Develop committee and recruit members in order to revisit Heritage Park Master Plan; partner with MPHA and City of Mpls to develop housing plan; and continue engagement around the Bottineau LRT and Van White transit stop planning.

Environment, Livability & Safety: Expand the community priorities discussion & planning to include specific programming & opportunities; determine committee purpose; add one additional staff & community organizer; create more opportunities for community gardens; seek out partners to help with the creation of Health & Wellness Initiatives, programs, and activities.

Economic Development: Expand the community priorities discussion & planning to include specific programming & opportunities; engage International Market Square residents, & businesses on Glenwood; increase community engagement and awareness of health equity issues, programs, and initiatives.

Leadership Development & Youth Engagement: Increase BOD members to include 1 or more community organizations/businesses including IMS; continue ongoing BOD member recruitment, training & development; ensure BOD members understand the fiduciary responsibility to the organization; have at least one Sumner-Glenwood resident on the following boards & commissions: MPHA Commissioner, Mpls City Planning Commission, Bike Walk Pedestrian Commission; NCR Commission.
