Cedar Lake South Beach

On January 10, 2018, the CIDNA Board approved the creation of a Neighborhood Priority Plan for Cedar Lake South Beach – including authorization to allocate of up to \$20,000 from the neighborhood’s Community Participation Program funds if funds are needed for the improvements in the future.

The Cedar-Isles-Dean Neighborhood Association (CIDNA) has, for many years, been making attempts to enter into a cooperative planning process with the Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board (MPRB) for redesign and improvements at Cedar Lake South Beach. Proposals and drawing for improvements date as far back as 1996.

In 2014, CIDNA provided \$40,000 from its Neighborhood Revitalization Program (NRP) to fund a planning process for the redesign of South Beach. The redesign was developed through a community engagement process, including a series of public meetings in 2015 and an additional meeting in 2017.

The design and implementation of the South Beach project continues to be a priority for CIDNA as it works with MPRB and a private donor to ensure that the project is implemented within the project budget and the construction is completed by July 2018.
