

**Neighborhood Name:** Marcy-Holmes Neighborhood Association (MHNA)

**Neighborhood Approval Date:** February 20, 2018

**NCR Approval Date:** March 2, 2018 (effective)

**Parking Issues:** Since summer 2017, MHNA’s Transportation Committee has focused on the parking issues in the neighborhood. Many areas are “over---parked,” making it difficult to find a space. There are parking violations that exacerbate the situation and put drivers, pedestrians and put drivers, pedestrians and bikers in danger. Neighbors are looking to the neighborhood association to solve the problem, and parking was a high priority item in the Board’s own review of key issues for 2018.

Having met with City Parking and Parking Enforcement offices, MHNA is currently pursuing three projects to address this situation:

1. Giving neighborhood residents information of how to solve parking issues in their area.
2. Establishing a “Neighborhood Parking Watch”, a neighborhood initiative to “tag: parking violators with a note explaining they are illegally parked and have been reported to 311.
3. Conducting a parking study to establish, on the West Side, the causes of “over-parking” on various streets. MHNA know that the East Side is continuously parked up due to residential density and University commuters.
