Neighborhood Priority Plan Contract Modification

The Windom Community Council's Youth Programs Neighborhood Priority

The Windom Community Council (WCC) proposes the approval of Youth Program activities as part of its Neighborhood Priorities contract strategy.

Currently, WCC, in partnership with the Minneapolis Public Schools – Windom Immersion School and the Minneapolis Parks and Recreation Board, implements two youth programs aimed at empowering and supporting youth.

In 2018, WCC began a neighborhood engagement initiative that we anticipate will have youth engagement and youth development implications for its current strategic planning efforts. With this approval, WCC plans to support current youth programs and invest in prospective new youth engagement and development activities.

WCC proposes the use of Neighborhood Priority funds to operate Youth Programs and provide funding of up to \$25,000 allocation which is to come from the \$107K+ the Windom Neighborhood Priority reserve.
