The Kenny Neighborhood Association (KNA) proposes a new Neighborhood Priority to provide safety and security rebates to residents as an incentive to make upgrades to their homes.

Nuisance crimes and crimes of opportunity have increased in recent years in Kenny. There are now a multitude of simple, low cost upgrades which residents can make to their homes to deter these types of crimes. Additionally, there are simple safety enhancements that can be made to ensure the physical health and safety of residents.

KNA would like to support its residents in a way that is low-cost and broad based. By providing safety and security rebates we are encouraging all households, owned or rented, to make upgrades which will provide increased safety/security and a sense of peace. The rebates will cover such things as, but not limited to: motion detector lighting, security cameras and doorbells, window pins, deadbolt locks, fire and carbon monoxide detectors, etc.

To accomplish this Priority Plan, we will Plan Mod \$3696.96 from two under-utilized NRP Phase II Action Plan strategies to this newly identified priority within our Community Participation Plan. A public vote approving both the funding mechanism and Priority Plan was taken during the Kenny Annual Meeting on April 16, 2019.
