Narrative:

E15 arrived to the rear of the residence after at least 5 MPD squads to reports of potentially 4 patients. MPD informed E15 as we arrived that a male was DOA inside with "brain matter everywhere". Outside and to the rear of the residence where multiple officers and 3 civilians, An adult female a juvenile female [REDACTED] 13.82 and a juvenile male [REDACTED] 13.82 The adult Female was sobbing and hard to understand but eventually said she had been stabbed in the back. FFR Creapeau was tending to her and along with MPD attempting to find a wound. The paramedics arrived and I updated them as they approached and directed their attention to the juvenile female who was screaming and saying she couldn't hear anything. One of the paramedics also verified that the Adult male was DOA. I along with one of the officers questioned the juvenile boy who said he was "[REDACTED] years old, His name was [REDACTED] 13.82 - Law Enforcement [REDACTED] After determining he had no physical injuries. My attention returned to the juvenile female who was still screaming. One of the paramedics along with FFR Creapeau picked her up using a fore and aft carry and moved her to the ambulance. The adult Female and boy were also escorted to the ambulance with police. Once all three were in the ambulance along with at least one officer, E15 was released, gathered their equipment and returned to service.
