

Pool operations manual

All public pool operators must have an Operations Manual with information on all pool equipment.

Staff must have access to the operations manual.

Required information

Your operations manual **must** contain the following information:

- Manufacturer's specification sheets for
 - Drain Cover(s) (SOFA)
 - Skimmer equalizer cover(s) (suction outlet)
 - Pump
 - Filter
 - Heater/thermometer
 - Pool cover
- General maintenance procedures for
 - Superchlorination
 - Backwashing
